10. **NOW THEREFORE**, in pursuance of Section 10 A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Commission of India hereby declares **Shri Mrutyunjay Swain, (Anarakshit Samaj Party), At-Naada, PO-Ambasal, PS-Balikuda, Dist. Jagatsinghpur, Odisha-754119**, the contesting candidate for the General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Odisha, 2019 from 103-Balikuda-Erasama Assembly Constituency of the state of Odisha to be disqualified for being chosen as and for being a member of either House of Parliament or the Legislative Assembly or Legislative Council of a State or Union Territory for a period of three years from the date of this order.
