Introduction:

Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya is an ambitious initiative by the Govt. of Odisha to provide quality education in English medium to rural children of Odisha practically at no cost or at best at low cost. It has been planned to open one OAV in each block of Odisha in phased manner. The beginning has been made with 100 OAVs in First Phase and in 250 Schools with effect from the academic year 2026-27 and the opening of new OAVs in left out blocks are continuing. All OAVs are being affiliated to CBSE. The entry level is Class-VI and it has been planned to map these institutions' centers of excellence with

provision of education up-to class-XII. Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas have infrastructure and facilities of the same standard as Kendriya Vidyalaya and JNVs with stipulation on Pupil-Teacher ratio, ICT usages, holistic educational environment, appropriate curriculum and emphasis on output and outcome.

Key features of Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas:

- The objective is to provide high quality English medium Education to the rural talents.
 - Vidyalaya's has a holistic and integral approach touching upon physical & aesthetic development in addition to academic.
 - There are 17 rooms on the ground floor and 15 rooms in 1st floor including 16 Smart Classrooms and other facilities.
 - Vidyalaya has adequate ICT infrastructure and internet connectivity.
 - There is sufficient scope for sports and co-curricular activities.
 - There is provision of Computer Teacher besides subject teachers.
 - Special emphasis is given on teaching of Science, Math and English.
 - There is provision of well-equipped laboratories and e-library.
 - Medium of instruction is English and the Vidyalaya is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi.
 - The Vidyalayas have appropriate pace setting activities, so that Vidyalayas in the neighborhood can benefit from it.
 - The classes are from VI to X with two sections with intake capacity of 40 in each section & XI to XII with with intake capacity of 40 Seats.
 - The reservation of seats for students will be as per the guidelines of OAVS.
- All efforts will be made to make it really a centre of excellence.

Curriculum for +2 Higher Secondary (Science Stream)

(A) Scholastic Areas:

1. There will be 5 subjects in class-XI. These are
 - (i) **English Core (Code 301)** [Theory 80 marks + IA 20 marks]
 - (ii) **Mathematics (Code 041)** [Theory 80 marks + IA 20 marks]
 - (iii) **Physics (Code 042)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
 - (iv) **Chemistry (Code 043)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
 - (v) **Biology (Code 044)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
2. Apart from the above 5 subjects the following subjects are to be offered as Elective / 6th Optional Subject.
 - (i) **Physical Education (Code 048)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks] /
 - (ii) **Painting (Code 049)** [Theory 30 marks + Practical 70 marks] /
 - (iii) **Information Technology (Code 802)** [Theory 60 marks + Practical 40 marks]
3. There is no alternative subject in addition to the above 6 subjects. All 6 subjects of class XI will be continued to class-XII without any change.
4. Each subject carries 100 marks.
5. Physics, Chemistry & Biology subjects have practical of 30 marks and theory of 70 marks. Students need to pass in Theory and Practical / IA separately

(B) Co-Scholastic Areas:

The Co-Scholastic activities are used as both cognitive and non-cognitive development of students can take place by exploring the child to the lesson on scholastic subjects and non-scholastic subjects. Each school has to keep following the co-scholastic subjects:-

- (i) General studies.
- (ii) Health & Physical Education.
- (iii) Work Experience.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS INTO CLASS XI IN OAVs,
2026 -27

1. Intake Capacity

- a. Science – 40 (01 Section with 40 Students)

2. Subject Combination

a. Science

- i. Compulsory subject- English Core
- ii. Elective subjects-Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Computer Science
- iii. Optional subjects-Physical Education/ Painting/ Information Technology/ Artificial Intelligence are to be offered as elective/ 6th optional subject following CBSE guideline and any other instruction issued by OAVS.

(N.B: Minimum 4 electives must be taken including Physics and Chemistry)

3. Minimum Eligibility

- a. CLASS XI (SCIENCE)
- b. A student belonging to the **General/OBC/SEBC** must have secured **55% and above marks in aggregate** along with **minimum 50% marks in both Mathematics and Science (combined)** in Class X board examination.
- c. A student belonging to the **SC/ST** category must have secured **50% and above marks in aggregate** along with **minimum 45% marks in both Mathematics and Science (combined)** in Class X board examination.

4. Students shall apply for one stream or more than one stream indicating the priority.

5. All notifications and circulars issued by CBSE shall be followed for subject combination in Class XI as per stipulated guidelines.

6. Order of preference for admission:

- a. Students of own OAV.
- b. Students of other OAVs (of same district, not having Class XI).
- c. Students of other OAVs (of same district, having Class XI).
- d. OAV students of other districts.

- e. Students of Government/ Government aided High schools within the same block.
 - f. Students of Private High schools within the same block.
 - g. Students of Government/ Government aided High schools of other blocks of the district.
 - h. Students of Private High schools of other blocks of the district.
 - a. Students of Government/ Government aided High schools of other district.
 - j. Students of Private High schools of other district.
 - k. Students of Other states.
7. In all cases selection shall be done on the basis of merit i.e. the marks secured in their Class X Board examination (CBSE or any other Board) as detailed in point no.3.
 8. Principals are requested to prepare prospectus for admission in Class XI which may be supplied to the applicants for admission.
 9. All OAV Principals (having Class XI) can spend a maximum of Rs 3000/- towards popularisation of Class XI admission. The said amount to be met from Vidyalaya contingency of the concerned OAV.
 10. OAVS HO shall communicate Schedule of admission to all concerned after publication of CBSE Board Class X result.
